



STUDENT VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!

A Midsummer Night's Run, Toronto's premiere night-time 30K run, will be held on Saturday August 18th, 2012 at 5:30PM. We're proud to be raising money for our charity partner - The Department of Rheumatology at Sick Kids Hospital!

Our race route is located along Toronto's Eastern Beaches and waterfront – Ashbridge's Bay and Tommy Thompson Park. Our start/finish area is at McLeary Park at Bouchette Avenue and Lakeshore Road East (at the Gardiner Expressway off ramp).

Volunteers are needed in many capacities and at different times throughout our "long" day and evening. We have the greatest need for volunteers from 8:00AM Saturday morning until 11:30PM Saturday evening. We also have shifts at our Race Kit Pick-up location (Ryerson Universities – Ted Rodgers School of Management at Yonge and Dundas) on Thursday, and Friday and a Sunday morning clean up shift. Shift lengths can vary based on duties and times are subject to change.
